## Senator Anna Caballero Secures a Supermajority of Delegate Votes Cast By Local Democratic Party Delegates

*Builds Momentum to Secure California Democratic Party Endorsement in March*

**FRESNO-** Senator Anna M. Caballero (**D-Merced**) made a very strong showing today at the California Democratic Party Pre-Endorsement conference for State Senate District 14. Securing 78.8% of the votes cast, this victory sets the stage for her to earn the California Democratic Party Endorsement at the State Convention, March 3-5. She also established a successful nonprofit, Partners for Peace, aimed at reducing youth violence. Senator Caballero served in local government for 15 years and in 2011, she joined Governor Edmund G. Brown’s cabinet where she served as Secretary of Business, Consumer Services and Housing Agency. She was also the first Latina elected to represent the 28th Assembly District and is currently serving her third year in the California State Senate where she proudly represents Merced, Madera and Fresno Counties.*
