State Senator Anna Caballero Launches Re-election Campaign

State Senator Anna Caballero today announced that she will run for re-election in the Central Valley Senate District 14, and issued the following statement:

"I have represented Merced, Madera and Fresno counties since my election to the California State Senate in 2018. In 2022, I will ask the voters to allow me the honor of continuing to represent them in the California State Senate."

Anna Caballero was first elected to the California State Senate in 2018, after previously serving 6 years in the California Assembly. She was the highest-ranking Latina in Governor Jerry Brown's cabinet from 2011-2015, serving as Secretary of the California Business Consumer Services and Housing Agency.
